Notice of Intention to Designate Property of Historic or Architectural Value

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of South-West Oxford intends to designate as property of architectural or historical value or interest the following property for the following reasons:

PROPERTY: MT. ELGIN BAPTIST CHURCH

REASONS: Architectural Reasons:

The building is an interesting and attractive

example of a wood frame church of the early 1860's

and is in excellent condition.

Historical Reasons:

Residents of Mt. Elgin and District and members of the Mt. Elgin Baptist Church regard this building as being a focal point of family and village life in the past and an important feature of the social and cultural development

of the village and surrounding district.
