
TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Stratford intends to designate the properties, at the following municipal addresses as properties of architectural and historical value or interest under Part IV, of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337.

- (b) MUNICIPAL ADDRESS: 210 Cambria Street, Stratford  
REASONS FOR THE PROPOSED DESIGNATION: Built in 1870, this Gothic house was once the home of Lt.-Colonel McComb, a commanding officer of the Perth Regiment in 1939-1940.

A picture taken from 1884 indicates many of the Gothic features which are now missing. These include the bargeboard, finials, and the front porch with gingerbread. These features will be included in the designation as well as the original chimneys, masonry, windows and roof.

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts shall be served on the Clerk of the City of Stratford, before the 1st day of June, 1992.
