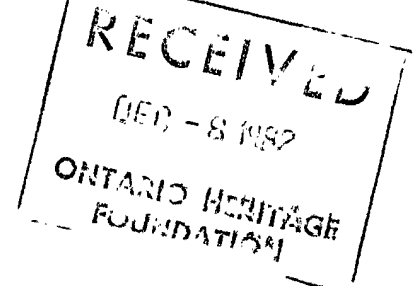

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TAY

BY-LAW NO. 1862

Being a by-law to designate Waubaushene Memorial Church as property of an architectural and historical value and interest.

WHEREAS Subsection 6 (a) of Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980 as amended, empowers municipal councils to pass by-laws respecting heritage designation;

AND WHEREAS pursuant with Subsection 1,3 and 4 of Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980 as amended, the municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Tay caused a notice to be published for three consecutive weeks in a newspaper having general circulation in the municipality, and served the notice on the owner of the property and on the Foundation;

AND WHEREAS no notice of objection was served under Subsection 5 of Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Tay deems it expedient to pass such a by-law;

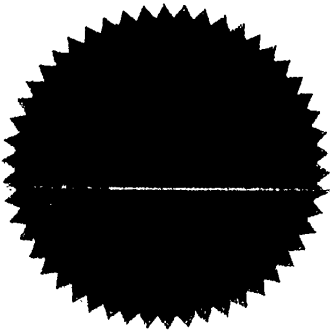
NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Tay enacts as follows:

1. That the land and building being Part Lot 95, Plan 690, Concession 11, fronting on Hazel Street in the hamlet of Waubaushene is hereby designated as property of an architectural and historical value and interest.

THIS BY-LAW SHALL COME INTO FORCE AND TAKE EFFECT UPON THE DAY OF THE FINAL PASSING HEREOF.

BY-LAW READ A FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED on this the 10th day of November, 1982.
