#### THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CALEDONIA

#### BY-LAW NO. 5, 1989

A By-Law to designate the property known municipally as Proulx Cheese Factory as being architectural and/or historical value or interest.

WHEREAS section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historic value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Caledonia has caused to be served on the owners of the land and premises known as "The Proux Cheese Factory" at "R.R. # 2 VANKLEEK HILL (Ontario)" and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks together with the reasons for designation.

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the clerk of the municipality;

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Caledonia enacts as follows:

- There is designated as being of architectural and/or historical (1)value or interest the real property known as "Proulx Cheese Factory" at "R.R.# 2 VANKLEEK HILL (Ontario)", more particularly described in schedule "A" hereto.
- (2) The municipal solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" hereto in the proper land registry office.
- The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law (3) to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.

### SCHEDULE "A"

In the Township of Caledonia, in the County of Prescott and being composed of Part of the East Half of the South Half of Lot Number 7 in the Fifth (5th) Concession of the said Township and more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at the South East corner of the East Half of the South Half of the said lot;

THENCE extending Westerly along the concession road between the 5th and 6th concessions of the said township, a distance of One Hundred and Five (105') feet;

THENCE Northerly at right angle a distance of Two Hundred and Ten (210') feet to a post planted;

THENCE Easterly to the nine mile Road between Lots 6 and 7, a distance of One Hundred and Five (105') feet;
