


# CROSSING TOWER

Almost always utilizing a floor plan that is Cruciform or Greek Cross, the crossing tower massing requires an intersection of two halls at right angles with a tower that rises above the roof line by at least a full storey. This massing is rare in smaller houses of worship and tends to require considerable scale in order to be feasible. Towers are typically square in plan and form the dominant feature of the building's roof. Examples: 1. All Saints Kingsway Anglican Church (Toronto), 2. Trinity Anglican Church (Bradford), 3. St. Sava Serbian Orthodox Church (Mississauga), 4. St. George Ukrainian Orthodox Church (Fort Frances)
