


HALL OR RECTANGULAR



The simplest of plans, it is rectangular in shape, with or without aisles, and generally uniform in height throughout. In hall churches, there are no transepts and no clerestory. The nave and aisles are covered by a single-span roof. Examples: 1. King Christian Church (King), 2. Old Stone Church (Beaverton), 3. St. Paul's Presbyterian Church (Hamilton), 4. St. Leonard's Anglican Church (Rockingham)
