


CENTRAL TOWER

A central tower is one that is centrally located on the façade, rising above the roof line by at least a full storey. The central tower is typically the main entrance to the building. The buildings are normally symmetrical on either side of the tower axis. Examples: 1. St. Thomas Pioneer Anglican Church, 2. Erindale Presbyterian Church (Mississauga), 3. St. John's Roman Catholic Church (Tay), 4. St. Andrew's United Church (Blind River)
